APOSTLE VS DISCIPLE

THE TERMS "APOSTLE" AND "DISCIPLE" ARE OFTEN INTERCHANGED BUT IN REALITY, HAVE DISTINCT MEANINGS. "APOSTLE" IS DERIVED FROM THE GREEK "APOSTELLO," MEANING "TO SEND FORTH."

"DISCIPLE" IS DERIVED FROM THE LATIN "DISCIPULUS," MEANING A "STUDENT" OR "PUPIL."

The 12 Apostles

AN APOSTLE IS SOMEONE CHOSEN AND SENT BY GOD TO PREACH THE GOOD NEWS OF SALVATION TO THE WORLD. JESUS CHOSE 12 APOSTLES WHEN HE BEGAN HIS MINISTRY AND SENT THEM OUT TO SPREAD HIS TEACHINGS.

RESURRECTION UPON ARRIVING AT THE
EMPTY TOMB. JESUS SAID TO HER, "BUT GO
TO MY BROTHERS AND TELL THEM, 'I AM
GOING TO MY FATHER AND YOUR FATHER, TO
MY GOD AND YOUR GOD." (JOHN 20:16-18)
